

Colombia: The Legal Profession still under attack

2010 Delegation Report Launch

In August 2010, a group of 57 lawyers from across the globe visited Colombia to assess situation facing Colombian human rights lawyers and members of the judiciary. This trip formed part of a commitment made by the first Caravana delegation visit in 2008 to continue to monitor human rights abuses of legal professionals . On 25th May the organisations involved in International Caravana of Jurists will be launching the 2010 delegation's report.

Present at the launch will be representatives of each of the organising bodies: Colombian Caravana UK Lawyers Group, Lawyers Without Borders Canada and ACADEUM - the Colombian umbrella organisation for human rights lawyers.
