	resistance, resulting in a total of 870 people being directly accompanied. The project organised 102 advocacy meeting with national
	authorities and facilitated 111 meetings to give human rights defenders access to the international community. The project
	completed more than 450 activities to disseminate information about the work and situation of human rights defenders.
	To support civil society and the reconstruction of the social fabric, the project held 66 meetings and facilitated 20 one-to-two-day
	workshops over a total of 71 days. The project is based in Bogotá, Barrancabermeja and Apartadó.

	the international community in Guatemala. The project met local, regional and national authorities 50 times and held 37 meetings
	with the diplomatic corps, the UN, other NGOs and international coalitions and networks.

	office in Mexico City maintained its core activities, adapting to the new work dynamics for the remainder of the year.
	Currently PBI Mexico accompanies 3 organisations and 2 civil society networks in the states of Puebla, Chihuahua, Coahuila and
	Mexico City. The project also started a capacity-building process with 5 new organisations through an agreement with the Semillas
	Fund organisation that works to improve the situation and condition of women in Mexico. 69 people benefited from the international
	accompaniment of PBI Mexico. Other civil society organizations received punctual support from PBI Mexico through requests for
	specific activities.
